

SECTION 6

Mitigation

FAA Order 1050.1E, *Environmental Impacts: Policies and Procedures* establishes significant impact thresholds for each of the environmental impact categories listed. The Order also identifies the conditions that normally indicate the threshold beyond which the impact is considered significant. If the Proposed Action would potentially result in impacts that are significant, then mitigation measures should be proposed to reduce potential impacts below the applicable significance thresholds.

The analysis of the potential environmental impacts as a result of the proposed 2,348-foot extension to Runway 9R-27L at TMB identifies the potential impact to Florida burrowing owls as the only significant impact that could occur. Measures are identified in Section 5.8 of this EA to mitigate this impact to a level that is less than significant.
