OPERATIONAL DIRECTIVE NO. 09 - 02

Effective: **12-25-09**

SUBJECT: PROHIBITED TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES ON THE AIRPORT OPERATIONS AREA

PURPOSE: To establish Departmental policy on restricting traffic and certain vehicle types not permitted to operate on the Air Operations Area (AOA) of Miami International Airport (MIA).

I. AUTHORITY:

- A. Chapter 25 of the Miami-Dade County Code, Miami-Dade Aviation Department Rules and Regulations. 25-9.
- B. Operational Directives (OD) No. 99-03, Written Directive System.

II. DEFINITIONS:

- A. AOA – Air Operations Area
- B. APV - Auxiliary Powered Vehicle (two or three wheel personnel transportation device, Segway)
- C. MDAD – Miami-Dade Aviation Department
- D. MDPD – Miami-Dade Police Department

III. POLICY:

For the continued safe and efficient transition of vehicle and aircraft traffic on the AOA, no Pedestrians, APV, Two-Wheeled or Three-Wheeled Personnel Transports, Bicycles, Tricycles, Scooters, Mopeds or Motorcycles will be permitted to transit through any AOA access gates or entrances. In addition, the foregoing vehicles will not be permitted to operate on any portion of the AOA.

IV. EXCEPTIONS:

- A. MDPD Motorcycles while used for law enforcement duties will be permitted to operate on the AOA.



Effective:

- B. APV, Two-Wheeled or Three-Wheeled Personnel Transports, Bicycles, Tricycles, Scooters, Mopeds or Motorcycles that are securely encased for shipment as cargo will be permitted on the AOA for shipping purposes only. Exceptions to this must be approved in advance, in writing, by the Airside Division Director or an Airside Supervisor.

IV. REVOCATION: If any court of competent jurisdiction determines that any provision in this OD is illegal or void, the remainder of this OD shall continue in full force and effect.
