Scope of Work: (Contractor must obtain and submit all permits prior to performing any work.) Scope of Services

The Contractor shall replace the electrical feeders the Training and Transition Airport, located at 54575 Tamiami Trail East, Ochopee, Florida, 34141 pursuant to the below requirements:

- A. Replace the underground 4160-volt feeder cables from the airfield vault to the AWOS Transformer so that FAA inspections can be passed and successfully certified. The feeders are approximately fifty-five (55) years old and approximately one (1) mile long.
- B. Remove all existing damaged #8 AWG cables and clean conduits, manholes as needed.
- C. Install new SHIELDED #6/ 5Kya or equivalent SHIELDED cables/ Approx. 3,700 ft each run x 4 runs = 14,800 ft of #6 AWG /copper wire. Rated @ 5Kva or SHIELDED equivalent.
- D. Install new UNSHIELDED AND/OR UNINSULATED, braided copper grounding cable #8 XHHW-2. Approx. 3,700ft each run x 1 runs = 3,700ft of #8 ground cable/ unshielded and/or uninsulated, braided copper wire 600 volts.
- E. Replace existing metal cables support by fiberglass (underground Application) UL type brackets. Prior to installation, the Contractor shall submit for approval by the MDAD Project Manager, the specifications on all wire and/or material being installed.
- F. Make splices at existing manholes as necessary for each cable run but limited to a maximum of three (3) with approve UL type/ watertight terminations rated for the apply voltage (5Kva). Prior to installation, the Contractor shall submit for approval by the MDAD Project Manager, the specifications on all wire and/or material being installed. From the Main high voltage Vault/ (5kva rated system) via the feeder duct bank manholes. Approximately 1 mile exists from the main Vault to the pad mounted 4160V to 240V transformer.
- G. The Contractor will be responsible for providing pump to remove water in manholes and dewatering at each manhole during the operation. The Contractor shall supply a non-metallic rack (plastic) in each manhole to support cables.
- H. The Contractor will be responsible for testing of all cable run insulation after their installation which shall be performed using a megger or appropriate wire insulation 5kv rated testing instrument before the system is energized. This is necessary to ensure the insulation integrity of all cable / wiring runs before energizing. 10ft of slack required to be left at each manhole. Identification tags are required at each cable at each manhole. Awarded contractor will provide fuse at the line side (high voltage) in the electrical room. Awarded contractor is

If in the process of replacing the underground feeder, it is found that not all manhole locations are identified (per Attachment A, " TNT Airport"), the Contractor shall advise the MDAD Project Manager and submit a change order request to employ an underground detection service so the Contractor can locate/identify any manholes not found. This additional work must be approved by the MDAD Project Manager prior to performance.

Additional Information:

- 1. Contractor is responsible for providing a repair permit, as required, including a feeder repair final acceptance letter signed & sealed by a licensed professional engineer to certify the installation. Any costs associated with the permit/certification shall be borne by the Contractor and should be contemplated by the Contractor in their Price Submittal for this RFQ.
- 2. The Contractor and their employees will not be required to acquire a MIA ID Badge or a GA ID Badge to work at TNT Airport for this project. However, everyone will be required to show a valid Driver; s License upon entry and have the information entered a log at the airport.
- 3. The Contractor shall comply with OSHA safety requirements and regulations, including but not limited to providing all necessary PPE to Contractor"s employees.
- 4. All areas of work including rooms are to be clean and clear of debris upon installation, completion and prior to final inspection by the Contractor.

In accordance with Sections 2-8.3 and 2-8.4 of the Code of Miami-Dade County and Implementing Order 3-21, this letter serves to notify you and all bidders on this solicitation that your firm has been recommended for award of the referenced Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) based on the bid submitted on Tuesday, March 8, 2022. Pursuant to the referenced legislation, the three (3) day protest period shall commence upon the posting of this recommendation to award. 
